PAC BUDGET

2019/2020

- Budget for year: \$33,372
- Budget Spent: \$25,691.60
- Reduction in spend due to Covid and early dismissal of school.
- Amount spent \$128.45 per child to enhance their learning environment.
- Spends include \$6000 on iPads and Laptps for classrooms
- Fundraising revenue: \$17.758
 - \$12,178 coming form fundraising and hot lunch program
 - \$1.295 in direct donations
 - \$4,060 from the Gaming Grant

2020/2021

- Budget approved: \$30,272
- Currently in bank: \$27,773
- Some of these funds will be moved to cover expenses incurred due to Covid, including plexiglass screens and wash stations.
