COVID UPDATE - Jill Reid

- Appreciate the work of families about wearing masks. The new rules for Grades 4 and 5 were adopted instantly and without issue, and has encouraged younger grades to try and wear masks more too.
- We are asked to remind kids that if they are outside and standing or walking close to each other then they need distance or wear a mask. Kids are listening to instruction when asked by supervisors and teachers, but just a reminder.
- In response to a question about whether schools will close, with the growing case numbers, Jill
 commented that it would take a lot to close schools by the Province, due to studies of the kids
 well being as well as its effect on the economy, and that she has faith in Coquitlam's systematic
 process when there is an exposure in a school

EDUCATION UPDATE: NUMERACY - Sandi David

- Sandi introduced Jen, an SD43 learning support teacher with numeracy focus. SD43's 2025 plan has a numeracy focus stem Stam and math
- Every Tuesday Jenn has a numeracy meeting with our teachers to share idea and resources
- It was explained that numeracy in primary is about number sense recognizing numbers, patterns, shapes and symmetry, using manipulatives and representing numbers in different ways.
- Numeracy for intermediate's is about building fluency with math facts, building knowledge and introducing new concepts. This year the kids have received a math kit, including playing cards, dice, fraction pieces, mini clocks and more.

- Sandi shared a video showing us the kids learning math in class and the many tactics that teachers use.
