PRINCIPAL UPDATE - Jill Reid

- No update on COVID protocols. Everything remains the same.
- 2021/22 School Timetable update:
 - Proposal to amend start time, to first bell at 8:46 AM with finish time remaining at 2:40 PM.
 - These times were agreed by the PAC members present at the meeting. Parents are asked to email Jill with any significant concerns about the new times.
 - "Community" time in the gym was in the pre-pandemic timetable and will be built back into the schedule at the start of the day, It is hoped this will be in person in the gym in September, depending on COVID.
 - The 40 minute break will be outside time. Teachers will continue with an "instructional lunch" before or after the outside break doing read alouds etc. while students eat, in the coming school year.
- 2021/22 Calendar for approval:

 - There are 2 additional Pro D days that the school can choose the dates of. Jill proposed January 31 and June 6, in line with the previous years.
 - o These dates were agreed by the PAC members present at the meeting. .
- 2021/22 Students and Classes:
 - It is expected that the school will remain around 200 students next year. We have a large exiting Grade 5 class, so we may have slightly less students, depending on who enrolls between now and September.
 - o There will be 10 divisions again: 6 Neighbourhood and 4 Montessori.
- Jill shared a Movie at the end of the meeting of what has happened at the school.

GRADE 5 - Tina Papa

- During the meeting on April 27, a plan was agreed for this year's Grade 5's. They will
 receive a swag bag and yearbook, and participate in a video recognition assembly. The
 school will also plant a legacy tree, funded through a Krispy Kreme fundraiser lead by
 the schoo (Jill)I.
- Next Grade 5 parent meeting will be May 25
- If COVID guidelines change after the long weekend, the committee will relook at plans for the Grade 5's.
- Jill thanked the Grade 5 parents and Tina for being so good about the plans and making it all work.

TREASURER REPORT - Zoe Sanbourn

- Zoe thanked exiting treasurer, Juliet, for her help with the spreadsheets and report.
- We are currently looking on track for this year's budget and next year's fundraising.
 - Revenue total for April 2021 \$2647.03
 - o Expenses for April 2021 \$2080.08
 - Projected balance for end of year \$19,800.00
 - Available for next year \$25,800.00
- It was commented that the remaining budget to carry over is comparable to non COVID years, which was praised, due to the reduced fundraising, in particular Hot Lunch, we have had this year due to COVID. Erin and Terri were thanked for their ability to adapt and find new ways.

FUNDRAISING REPORT - Erin McKinley

- Plant Sale Terri Besworth
 - One of the most successful plant sales
 - o Income \$1900 of plants 22 people
 - Made \$458 profit
- Mini Family Photo Shoots Terri Besworth
 - Photo shoot in April had to be delayed due to rain.
 - Rescheduled date is May 22, 2021
 - There are still places available. We need at least one more family.
 - Reminded that the shoot is just 10 mins and you receive 4 professional photos for \$50.
 - Noted that it doesn't have to be a whole family, you can just do photos of the kids, or grad pictures for Grade 5's.
- Art Cards for Kids Erin McKinley
 - Art has been created in class, lead by teachers. Each class had a theme and will be printed on a greeting card.
 - Erin will be sending them to Art Cards by Kids to be produced.

- o Ordering will be online through the company and shipped direct to home.
- Frozen Fridays Erin McKinley
 - Freezies every Friday
 - \$10 for 7 freezies
 - Option to add siblings who don't attend
 - Jill and teachers will be handing them out to prevent parents being in the school.

 - o Gift voucher fundraiser
 - Will run in May/June in time for Summer
 - Hard copy order forms will be sent home with kids.
- Ongoing fundraising

 - Return It Coquitlam
 - Oliver's Labels
 - o Flip Give
- Orange Shirts (Orange Shirt Day/Every Child Matters) Colleen O'Connor
 - Proposal to sell Tshirts before end of this school year, as Orange Shirt Day is observed before the Parent Council will be back up and running in September and because it takes time to produce the shirts.
 - The discussion will continue between Erin and Colleen and will be presented in the June PAC meeting.

- It is to be confirmed if buying school supplies will be centralized for 2021/22. It is noted that the PAC reclaimed %3's of the previous year's money via voluntary donation.
- Michelle Hunt put forward the motion to accept the budget, Colleen O'Connor seconded the motion.
- It was noted that the budget did not include fundraising to replace the school playground and that it will become a separate committee with targeted fundraising.
 - Jill noted that we are not in a position for a grant from the district, there may be other grants that come up, and we will continue to monitor the availability.
