- Report Cards: On December 7th Report cards will be sent home.
- Feeding Futures Program:
 - Coordinator: Brooke Townsend, School Counselor.
 - Purpose: To assist families in combating food insecurity, acknowledging the rising cost of living and grocery prices.
 - Supports Available: Families in need of food assistance are encouraged to contact the school. Supports include bagged lunches and gift cards for families to use as they see fit.
 - Accessibility: Efforts are being made to make snacks available in classrooms, providing easier access for students in need during the school day.
- STEAM Initiative:
 - Guest: Nicole Cruz, STEAM ambassador, has been working with Baker students.
- Winter Concert:
 - Dates: December 18-19 (Monday-Tuesday) afternoons.

- Reason for Scheduling: Mr. Rojas is available on these days, ensuring staff and student participation.
- Tickets: Two tickets per family for each show. Tickets will be distributed to the eldest Baker student in each family on December 12.

- Plans for January:
