Called to Order – Jacqueline Stevens (Co-Chair)

- Jacqueline Stevens welcomed everyone to the meeting and introduced herself and Daniel Heimdahl as the new co-chairs of the PAC.

Approval of Meeting Minutes From November 12, 2024 and Agenda

Corinne Hansen moved to approve the minutes and agenda, and Colleen O'Connor seconded.

Principal Update - Joe Jamieson

- Mr. Jamieson talked about the success of the choir, and how the staff is looking for additional opportunities to engage in preferred choice activities, especially during breaks such as recess and lunch. There are numerous students who are actively including others, however some students struggle to manage their time outside, especially during the end of lunch. The choir has now expanded to welcome intermediate students. Caregivers and students are welcome to reach out to Mr. Jamieson with ideas of specific activities that groups of students could engage in during breaks.
- Multi-cultural week is coming up, which was discussed in the newsletter. Caregivers are
 asked to look at their own culture and find something that represents their culture, and
 send a photo to Mr. Jamieson with a short description. Classes will participate in a
 Kahoot game during multi-cultural week as well. The school will also be updating the
 multi-cultural wall near the staircase.
- Staff update: Ty Goff will be returning to our school community.
- The district has allocated an extra one day a week of student service time to our school. This will be a job share with another school.
- Student update: We have four new students at our school: 2 in Ms. Kim's class, 1 in Ms. David's class, and 1 in Ms. Capel's class.
- The winter performances were a success, and were enjoyed by students and caregivers. Winter performances are a big undertaking for the school, and they help build community. This year we had a few classes perform each day for one week rather than one big performance.

Treasurer's Report - Mariana Perez-Garcia

- This update is for November and December, 2024, since we did not have a regular meeting in December.
- The total revenue for November and December was \$13,662.60. The total expenses for November and December were \$12,539.58. The general account had \$67,002.37 in it as of December 31st. The gaming account had \$2,243.84 in it as of December 31st. Total liabilities was \$8,997.95 as of December 31st. Total assets minus liabilities was \$60,248.26 as of December 31st.

DPAC Update – Christie Nelson

- There is going to be a new mobile-friendly app for MyEd that should be coming out this spring to access student information.
- There are some upcoming free sessions, such as digital safety for children, and a panel discussion on anti-racism, open to the public for caregivers in our school district.
