Principal's Update - Joe Jamieson

- The Grade Five Leaving Ceremony will take place on June 18.
- The Grade 4/5 science fair will take place on June 11.
- The talent show will take place on June 16.
- June 17 will be a spirit day with the theme Beach Day.
- June 23rd will be Water Play Day.
- Sports Day is this Friday. There will be a group of volunteers from Charles Best running the stations. Hip Hop performances will be at 1:15 PM, and families are welcome to watch.
- June 25 is the last day of school. Families are welcome to pick their children up at 12:00 PM, but if students need to remain at school until 2:40 that is fine, as long as the school is notified.
- Report cards go out on June 25th.

- The Code of Conduct will be updated and put on the website. One of the items is to do with toys, as more personal items have been ending up at school. - The proposed budget for 2026-2027 was voted in, with all in favor.
- The block party is upcoming on June 12. Freezie Fridays (and some Thursdays) are currently ongoing.
- Pre-orders are done for the block party, and the volunteers have put in a lot of great effort to make it a fun event. There will be a bouncy castle. Food is available to buy at the event if you did not pre-order.

- Total expenses were \$7,175.26.
